Parkinson's Awareness Month

Parkinson Canada defines Parkinson's Disease (PD) as a neurodegenerative disease. A chemical called dopamine is responsible for sending signals between nerves in the brain. When the cells that produce dopamine die, symptoms of Parkinson's appear.

Common Symptoms

- Tremor
- Slowness and stiffness
- Impaired balance
- Rigidity of the muscles

Other Symptoms

- Fatigue
- Sleep disturbances
- Problems with handwriting

At first, Parkinson's causes physical symptoms. Affects to cognitive function may arise later as the disease gets worse with time. Many people develop Dementia when the nerve cells degenerate; leading to chemical changes in the brain.

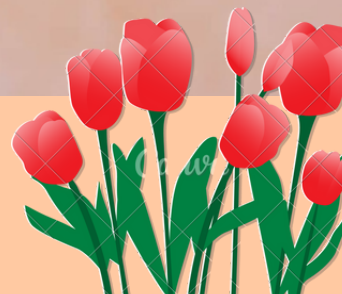
