Spinal Muscular Atrophy Awareness Month

Muscular Dystrophy Canada defines Neuromuscular Disorders as health conditions that are caused by genetic mutations or changes in the autoimmune system that in turn, impact muscles and/or the nerves that connect to muscles.

CureSMA works to address spinal muscular atrophy from all angles, including basic biological research, drug discovery, as well as clinical trials.

Evidence has shown that newborn screening can offer an early diagnosis, resulting in early intervention to promote better outcomes. According to Cure SMA, early intervention with available treatments lead to better outcomes. Early detection and timely administration of therapies can prevent the rapid and irreversible loss of motor function caused by the disease of Spinal Muscular Atrophy.




